



GENERAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Cart lids must be completely closed for prevention of windblown materials.
- ◆ Place your cart as shown in the diagram by 7:00 am on collection day.
- ◆ When collection day falls on a holiday, pick up will be pushed to the next day.
- ◆ All waste must be bagged and placed inside of your black cart.
- ◆ Any waste left beside the cart will **NOT** be collected.
- ◆ Please return your cart to your property before the end of collection day.
- ◆ In the event of severe weather (i.e. snow), please leave your cart curbside. Our trucks will provide service as soon as possible after conditions have cleared.
- ◆ Do not remove your cart from its assigned address.
- ◆ Do not paint or mark your cart.
- ◆ Please do not allow children to play in or near the collection containers or vehicles.
- ◆ Inform the Town Office at 306.948.3317 of any damage, vandalism, or theft of the cart as soon as possible.

The Golden Rule of Cart Collection

Keep 1 metre, or 3 feet, clear on all sides of the carts—including above them!

PROHIBITED ITEMS

We are permitted to only accept solid, non-hazardous waste materials such as general garbage and food waste. We do not accept regulated waste such as:



Hazardous Waste



Medical Waste



Electronics



Used Oil or Containers



Paint



Pressure Filled Containers

Other unsuitable waste for your cart:

- ◆ Any compostable material (grass clippings, tree clippings, dirt, etc.)
- ◆ Ashes of any kind
- ◆ Construction or demolition materials including concrete, boards, roofing materials, carpet, etc.
- ◆ Automotive parts, oil filters, batteries, tires, etc.
- ◆ Animal carcasses or animal parts
